

How Do You Decide?

There are three main routes for all students leaving school:

1. **Further education - going to a college or sixth form to study A Levels or a Vocational course. The additional qualifications may be for a job or may lead onto university**
2. **Apprenticeship or other Work Based Learning Programme. Combines work experience and qualifications.**
3. **Employment/Find a Job, which may have some element of training to it.**

Which you pick depends on what you want to do in the future. If you plan to go to university, you will need to consider going into further education, but you may decide you have had enough of education for now and want to be employed in a job, or an apprenticeship. Everyone is different. Don't just pick what your friends have chosen. Choose options best for you and your future.

However, don't hang around!

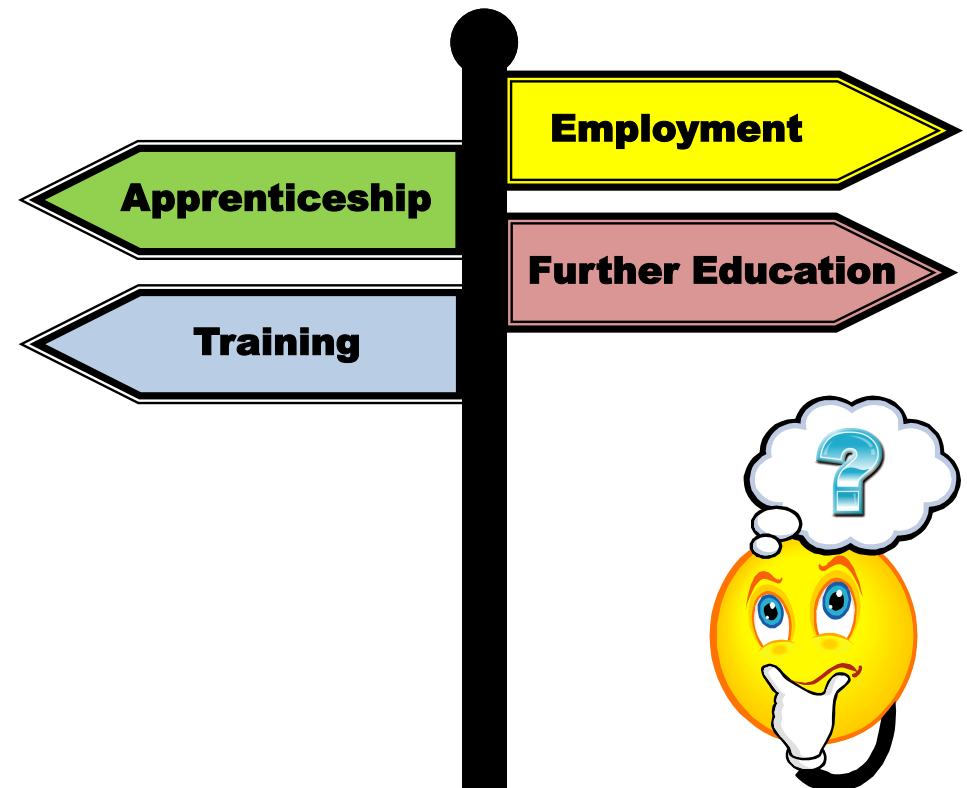
