

Remote Learning

Tuesday 5th January:

From Tuesday 5th January onwards, students in **Year 11** are required to be logged into their Google Classrooms from 9am each morning until 3pm each day. Attendance at each lesson is essential (unless the student is unwell and therefore unable to attend). The Google Classroom the student attends should match their timetabled lesson; it is currently week B on our timetable.

Once in the Google Classroom, the expectation is that the Year 11 student notifies the teacher that they are in attendance and a register will be taken. The teacher will be present online throughout each timetabled Year 11 lesson to support the class with their learning.

For all other year groups, 7-10, although some work may start to appear from some subject areas, students (on this day only) will **not** be following their timetable and should therefore complete published work via Bedrock, Communication and Hegarty maths. Additionally, we also recommend that students may pick lessons of interest from the vast array of materials made available on [Oak National Academy](#).

Wednesday 6th January:

From Wednesday 6th January onwards, all students in **all year groups** are required to be logged into their Google Classrooms from 9am each morning until 3pm each day. Attendance at each lesson is essential (unless the student is unwell and therefore unable to attend). The Google Classroom the student attends should match their timetabled lesson; it is currently week B on our timetable.

Once in the Google Classroom, the expectation is that the student notifies the teacher that they are in attendance and a register will be taken. The

teacher will be present online throughout each timetabled lesson to support the class with their learning.

If your child has been given an onsite place, and is expected in school on Tuesday 5th January, then they will be completing the same Remote Learning work as is being issued as above and the same protocols will apply. Please note, **students will need to bring their own headphones in with them for this.**
