

Dear Parent/Carer,

It has been a great start to the term this week with students returning full of enthusiasm and energy for the new academic year, well most of them have anyway! I am pleased to report that the departing Year 11 achieved the best results that we have seen for many years. As usual, we have many opportunities planned for students starting with our Pledge Day later this month, more details will follow next week. Our extra-curricular clubs are already up and running for Year 7 and will be in place for all year groups from next week, and finally the Sports and Performing Arts academies will start again in the coming weeks. Finally, an academisation update. For those of you who had children here last year, you will know that we consulted on converting to an academy in order to join the PELE Trust in February 2023. The outcome of the consultation was to proceed with the plan and I am now delighted to be able to confirm that we will be joining Pele on 1st November 2023. It is an exciting next step in the history of the school and we know that it will lead to improvements in what we can provide for our community. More details will follow in my updates in the coming weeks, but there is no need to worry as the only real change that you or the students will see is that our lanyards will be a different colour!
