Re: Introduction of the Combined Cadet Force (CCF) at John Spence

We are delighted to inform you that John Spence Community High School will be launching a Combined Cadet Force (CCF) unit from 1st September. This exciting initiative will provide our students with unique opportunities to develop valuable life skills, leadership qualities, and a sense of service and responsibility.

The CCF is a youth organisation sponsored by the Ministry of Defence and supported directly by Headquarters Northeast Cadet Training Team, which consists of both regular and former regular soldiers who bring a wealth of knowledge and experience. The CCF offers pupils structured training and experiences within a disciplined yet supportive environment.

Activities will include leadership exercises, fieldcraft, adventurous training, community service, and opportunities to gain recognised qualifications.

Through the CCF, our students will:

- Build teamwork, resilience, and self-confidence.
- Take on leadership roles and responsibilities.
- Engage in physical and outdoor challenges.
- Develop respect, self-discipline, and commitment.

## **Uniform and Equipment**

Students joining the CCF will be issued with their uniform free of charge. However, cadets will need to purchase their own suitable boots. If this presents any difficulty, please do not hesitate to speak with us in confidence — we are keen to ensure that no pupil is prevented from joining due to financial concerns.

## **Weekly Parade**

The CCF unit will parade every Monday from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Attendance at parade sessions is a core part of the programme and will allow cadets to take part in training, drills, and skill-building activities.



Participation is voluntary and open to pupils in Years 8, 9, and 10, with recruitment beginning in October. We will hold taster sessions on 13th and 20th October for students who would like to learn more about what the CCF involves — including the structure of the programme, uniform arrangements, and opportunities for training and camps.

We believe the CCF will be an outstanding addition to our wider curriculum, supporting the development of well-rounded young people who are well prepared for the challenges of adult life.
